(VACIHCS) includes the medical center and five Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs). VACIHCS employs over 1400 people who serve approximately 30,000 Veterans from more than 40 counties in Central Iowa and Northern Missouri. We provide a wide variety of services through inpatient, outpatient and support programs.

A Veteran's eligibility for care is based on eligibility laws passed by Congress to ensure medical care is provided to service-connected Veterans and to limited income Veterans. VACIHCS is also the designated Federal Coordinating Center for National Disaster Medical System activity in Central Iowa.
