

Knoxville CBOC On Track For Winter Opening

VA Central Iowa Health Care System is pleased to share that the future Knoxville CBOC, located at the corner of Lincoln and Longlane in Knoxville, Iowa is on track for a winter opening. As shown in the photos, work is being done on the west elevation, where the canopy will be located.



It is easy to see how the physical structures and work done by Graham Construction are starting to resemble the project renderings done by Horty Elving Architectural Firm. Extensive work is being done on the inside and outside alike, as drywall is being installed and weather guards and masonry work begin.



As a reminder, VA Central Iowa Health Care system continues to provide the best care/services to local Veterans at the current CBOC (located in Building 1 at 1515 West Pleasant Street) until the new lease space is open and ready for patients. The Department of Veterans Affairs Office of Asset and Enterprise Management (Washington, DC) continues to have a lease agreement of the full historical Knoxville campus with Knoxville Veterans Alliance (KVA) to develop the land under the enhanced use lease process.
